**'Food allergies can be life threatening.
Food Standards Scotland is here to help you prepare and manage the
information required for Scotland's new food labelling laws.'**

New legislation, which requires food businesses to include the product name and full ingredient list on all food prepacked for direct sale (PPDS), came into force across Scotland and the rest of the UK on October 1st 2021.

This means that it is now a legal requirement for businesses producing PPDS foods to label them with the name of the product, along with an ingredients list highlighting any allergens.

How is my business affected?

To find out how your business is affected, simply answer a few quick questions on the Food Standards Scotland website which will determine what you need to do to comply with these changes.
